

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY, ESTABLISHING RULES FOR THE PARKING OF LARGE TRUCKS AND OTHER VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, KENTUCKY; ESTABLISHING DEFINITIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES, PENALTIES, AND FINES FOR ANY VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Worthington, Kentucky, has the responsibility to provide for safe and accessible streets for the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, as part of this responsibility, the City believes it necessary to add and/or modify its parking regulations;

NOW BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Worthington, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any persons to park a truck, a truck-tractor, or any other vehicle whose manufacturer's gross weight exceeds 10,000 pounds in any residential section for longer than one hour, except when loading or unloading. City-owned vehicles or vehicles owned by other government entities or public utilities, or trucks owned by contractors of said governments or public utilities, are exempted from this provision while they are providing public maintenances in a designated residential zone.

SECTION II: Whoever violates this provision shall be fined not less than twenty dollars (\$20.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day in which the vehicle is parked in such an unlawful manner.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

SECTION IV: That all ordinances in conflict herewith are specifically hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict only.

SECTION V: That each section and each sentence of this ordinance is enacted separately and the invalidity and/or unconstitutionality of any one particular sentence and/or section shall not affect the validity and/or constitutionality of any other sentence and/or section.
